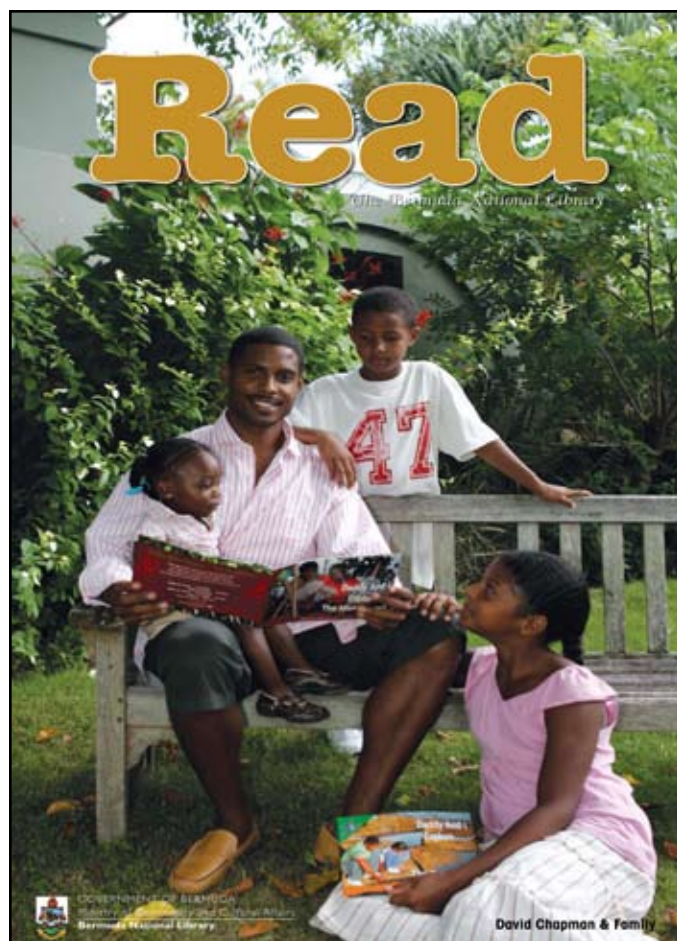

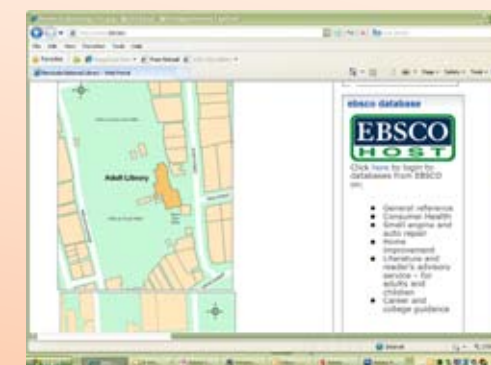

2 Scroll down until you come to the EBSCOhost icon



3 You'll reach this page where you'll need your library card.



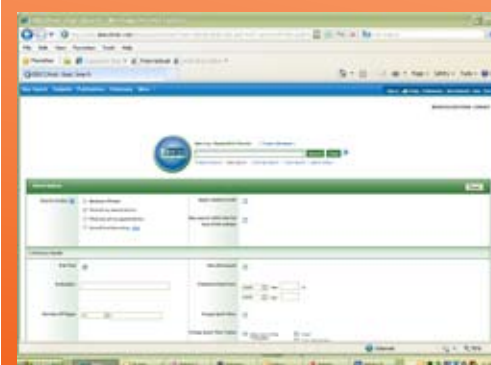
4 In the PATRON ID area add your library card ADL NUMBER.

6 A list of databases is provided, click on the appropriate one. In our case we are going to select MASTERFILES SELECT.



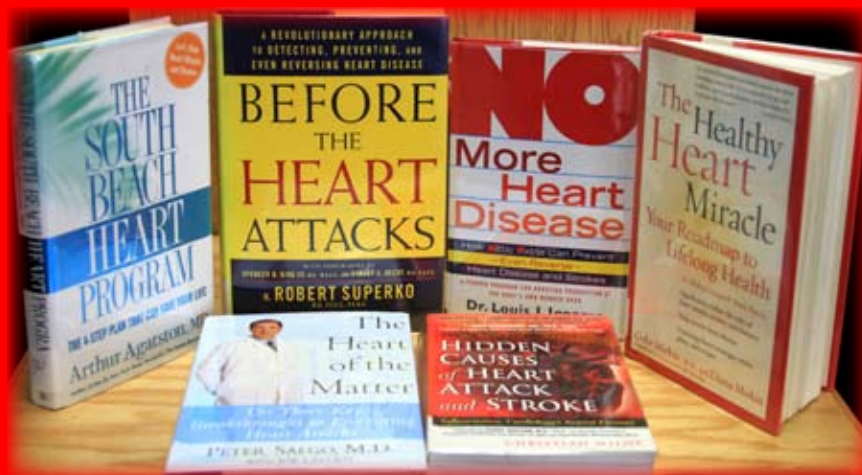
7 This leads to the SEARCH ENGINE. From there enter your search.

The other members of the board are the secretary, Sherlyn Swan, and the treasurer, Kathy Steele.

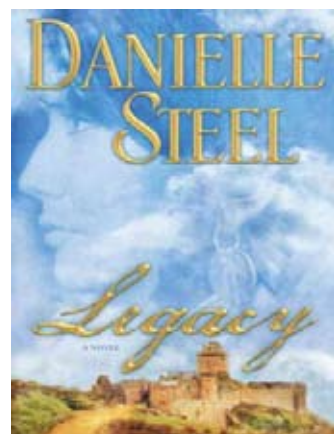
FNL was founded October 20, 1976, with charity status granted November 12, 1991. Over the years, the FNL has helped the library with funding and

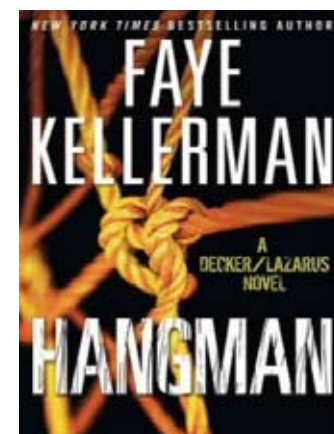

appointments for detailed instruction, particularly with regard to the EBSCOhost suite of databases, are also available.

EBSCOhost is an invaluable one-stop source containing several hundred thousand articles and images on a wide range of general themes, as well as specific areas such as biographies, business world topics, literary critical reviews and plot summaries, health and wellness matters, small engine and auto repair, home improvement projects, hobbies and crafts, advice on books to read for children and adults, and career path and college planning guidance. You can also go to EBSCOhost quickly and easily from your office or home computer, your mobile device, or at one of the Library's internet computers.

School students along with their parents or older brothers and sisters frequently come to the Information Desk in search of information pertaining to Bermuda-related homework assignments and projects. The Library's wide-ranging Bermudiana reference collection contains books, newspaper clippings and other material, much of which is accessed through the Bermuda Index, a combination of card and digitized subject guides compiled by the Library's Local Studies staff. It is also useful to know that you can access issues of *The Royal Gazette* up to 1899 as well as *The Bermuda Recorder* via the Library's website.

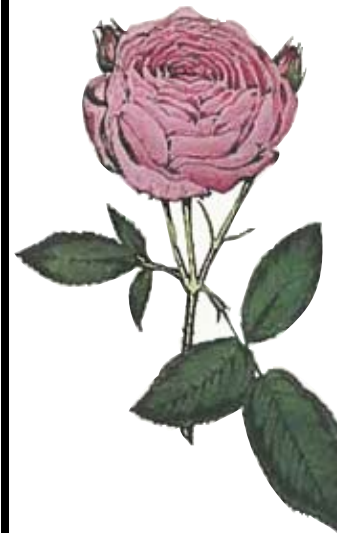

I have decided to tell you a little about the influence of "older people" on my life.

As a little girl, I was often carted around with an older neighbor lady whom I affectionately called "Aunt Lily" (Pitt). She was not a blood relative of mine, however there was no way you could have persuaded me that she was not, "my Aunt Lily". We used to get gussied up on some Sunday afternoons and we would go and have tea with her friends and visit her relatives! She called me "Lil' Junie", her version of my name of which I was made to feel was a very privileged endowment coming from her. She would endure my childish antics and exuberance with the patience of a saint! I was her "best girl". She let me help her grate cassava for her

delicious Christmas pies which she supplied to many hotels and guest houses at that time, (1956-58). I watched her "do napkins" for the same hotels, and assisted in "follin" pieces for

this person and that! She would stand for hours ironing chefs jackets and the like and probably received a mere pittance for her efforts, but she would turn out the whitest shirts, the best looking napkins ever and was a remarkable lady to say the least. She humoured me like I was her own and that trickled down to her grown sons who allowed me to "comb and curl" their silky tresses and put bows on, while she chuckled with great mirth at my attempts to make "Dinny" and "Trotty" look pretty. My happiness was always a priority even if my subjects would fall asleep during my ministrations. We did not have a television set at that time, so "Aunt Lily" and family would suffer through my choices of TV shows on a regular basis. I look back and I realize that these were people who helped shape me with their sincerity, long-suffering and kindness as next door neighbors. I'm sure I was a nuisance sometimes, however there was never a cross word uttered to me nor was there ever a time I did not feel welcome in their home. Thank-you "Aunt Lily", "Uncle Trotty" and "Uncle Dinny". Love Joan.
